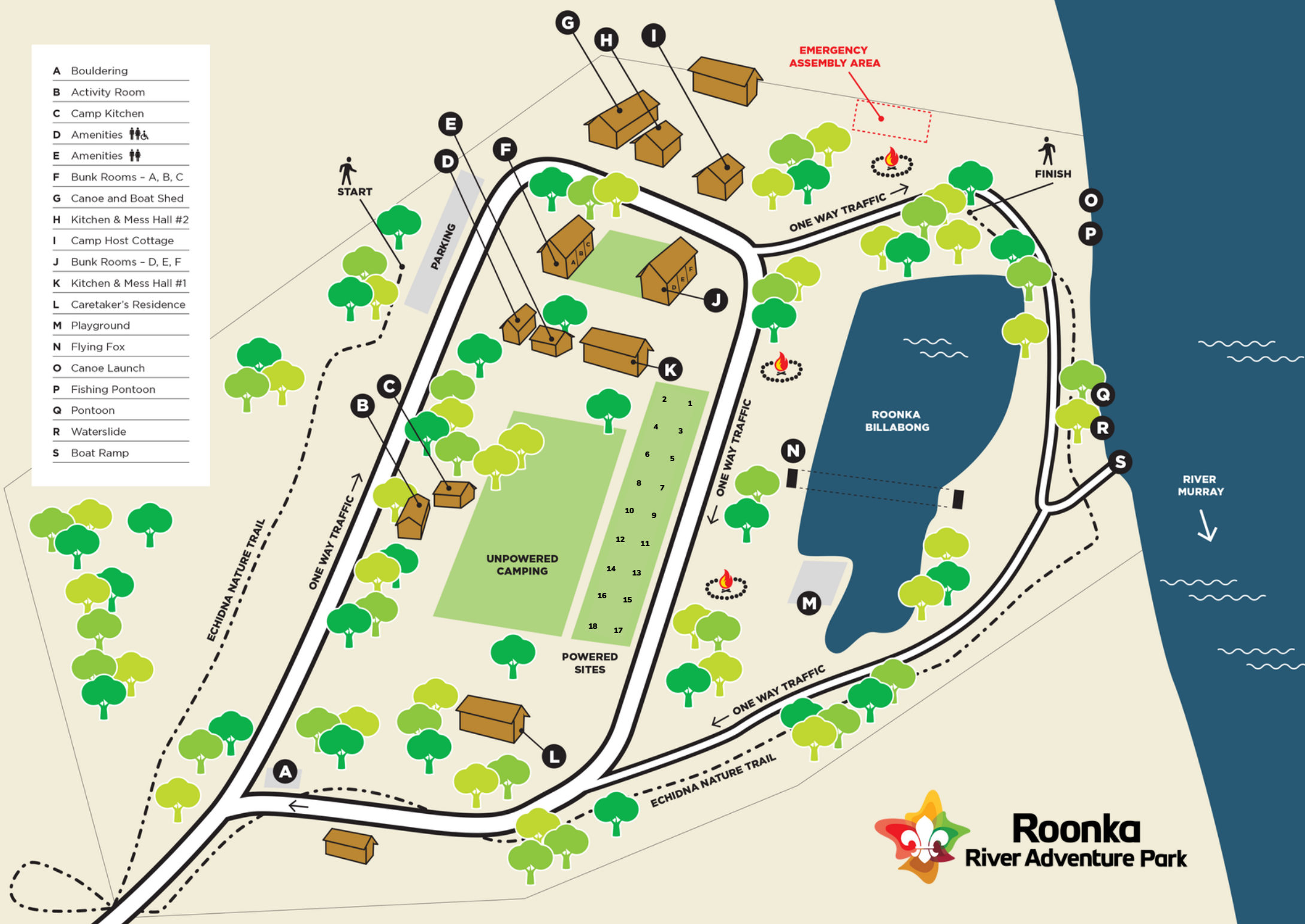

GUEST INFORMATION

While you're now officially on 'river time' there are just a few important times to note: Check in is 2pm and check out is 12pm, with noise curfew at 10.30pm.

DRINKING WATER

Rainwater is in limited supply and available for drinking purposes only from selected (clearly labelled) tanks and in the kitchens. If in doubt, please check with your Camp Host. Due to the varying taste and colour of rainwater, some guests prefer to bring their own drinking water. All other taps, including bathrooms, supply unfiltered river water (not suitable for consumption).

SMOKING / VAPING AND ALCOHOL CONSUMPTION

As a family-friendly campsite we are committed to setting a healthy and positive example for young people. Please drink responsibly and do not attempt any onsite activities under the influence. Smoking and vaping must occur well away from other guests, with butts disposed of considerately. Smoking and vaping is prohibited indoors.

DOGS

Small to medium dogs are welcome, and must be kept on lead at all times for their safety and the safety of others. Pets are not permitted indoors, including bell tents, kitchens and bunkrooms.

RUBBISH

Thank you for leaving the site as you found it, with rubbish placed in the provided bins. Please assist our recycling efforts by placing bottles (caps off), cans, paper and cardboard in the wire baskets.

CAMPFIRES

Outside fire danger season (generally May to November), campfires are permitted and must be within the three designated areas. Enjoy a campfire on us with wood provided for the communal fire circles!

ACTIVITIES

Diverse land and water-based recreational activities complete the Roonka experience, with access available to all guests staying on site, or visiting for the day...

PRINTED ACTIVITY RESOURCES – available from the Camp Host Cottage

- Wander along the **ECHIDNA NATURE TRAIL** and learn about our flora, fauna and environment.
- Reveal the secret words when you locate the correct checkpoints on two **ORIENTEERING COURSES**, ranging from 800m-1.3km in length.
- Use basic map reading and navigation skills to explore the property on a **PHOTO HUNT**.

FLYING FOX AND RIVERSLIDE

These activities operate during daylight hours. Just let your Camp Host know when you're ready to fly or slide and we'll get you on your way!

THERE IS NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY

- **CHILDREN MUST BE UNDER DIRECT ADULT SUPERVISION AT ALL TIMES.**
- All recreational activities including paddling, swimming and fishing are undertaken solely at the risk of the participant.
- Life jackets must be worn by **EVERYONE** in or on the water (provided to guests at no charge).

WATERCRAFT USE AND HIRE

- Guests are welcome to use the provided sit-on-top watercraft (free of charge) on the billabong only. Please do not remove from the area.
- See your Camp Host to hire canoes or kayaks for river use.

BOAT LAUNCH ACCESS

Please see your Camp Host for instruction when you're ready to launch.
