Adelaide Hills Kaurna & Peramangk Country

Woodhouse has you covered for all year levels, from excursions for junior primary and OSHC, fun-filled and action-packed camps for primary and early secondary years... through to retreats and team-building for senior students.

We offer four camp package options to suit all budgets and requirements, from DIY to fully facilitated and catered. Each package starts with bunk accommodation for two nights (three buildings sleep up to 190), large indoor activity spaces, a fully-equipped commercial kitchen, a huge array of unique opportunities for outdoor learning... and a whole lot of fun!

We also specialise in facilitated excursions, from nature-play activities for the younger kids through to team-building or high-adrenaline action for the older kids.

Perfect for ticking off curriculum links (think nature and the environment, leadership, problem solving) - or just for an active, fun and screen-free day out!

Onsite activities include an obstacle course, outdoor laser skirmish, waterless waterslides, disc golf, multi-dimensional bouldering wall, giant split-level maze, orienteering and more.







Riverland Ngaiawang Country

Nestled right on the banks of the mighty Murray River, about an hour and forty minutes north-east of Adelaide, Roonka has a range of facilitated outcome-based 2-night/3-day packages, with highlights in every season.

Choose either bunkhouse accommodation (sleeps up to 58 across six rooms), or tent camping for larger or more adventurous groups (or a combination!).

Facilitated activities range from survival skills (including campfires and camp cooking) to yabbying, geocaching and compass navigation. Add in aquatic activities in warmer months, such as raft building, water relays and ziplining across our private billabong!



Eyre Peninsula Nauo Country

With a bunkhouse sleeping 35 people (including private kitchen, recreation and dining hall) and powered/unpowered camping sites, Camp Nyroca is perfect for school groups. It's just 20 minutes from beautiful Coffin Bay, and 40 minutes from Port Lincoln.

Surrounded by century-old gums, the property has a natural bush setting, with Marble Range as its backdrop. Stunning beaches are just 15-20 minutes to the west, so while coastal experiences are within easy reach, you are away from the sand and wind of sites right by the beach. It has a fantastic modern amenities block with lovely hot showers.

A spacious Recreation Hall offers table tennis, sporting equipment and orienteering maps to help explore the 21-hectare property.
