

WELCOME TO WOODHOUSE

Nestled in the quiet of the Piccadilly Valley, Woodhouse Activity Centre offers six different styles of accommodation on the 54-hectare property, ranging from a gracious heritage-listed manor to quaint cabins; a purpose built conference centre to bush camping.

Whilst only a short trip up the South-Eastern freeway, the serene quiet of Woodhouse could be a million miles from the city hustle.

And there are loads of things to do! Explore the natural beauty of the creek and the property as a whole while orienteering, unleash your inner child on South Australia's favourite obstacle course, Challenge Hill, or just curl up on a rug under a tree and read a book, breathing in the fresh hills air and listen to native birdsong.



CHALLENGE HILL

One of the best of its kind in Australia, Challenge Hill is an obstacle course designed to challenge your ability to work as a team and show your leadership skills.

Stretch yourself physically and mentally as you crawl, climb, swing and slide your way around the course. It's not a race, it's a chance to show what you are made of. People of any age, any level of fitness and any level of competence can take up the challenge.



WEDDINGS AND FUNCTIONS

Venture into the 54 hectare property, over the bridge and through gum-tree studded countryside to find your own private retreat at Old Woodhouse Manor - the Crown Jewel of Piccadilly. This two story, heritage listed mansion is destined to provide the perfect backdrop or venue for any occasion.

DAY ENTRY

OLD WOODHOUSE MANOR

Built in 1863, this gracious two story heritage-listed manor offers two meeting rooms that are the perfect spaces for quiet retreats and reflective learning. Surrounded by a glorious colonial style garden, the Manor's courtyard offers a secluded and private area for outdoor activities.

Bunk-style accommodation for up to 60 guests in 10 rooms (BYO bedding unless pre-arranged) free WiFi, a modern well-equipped self-catering kitchen, large communal dining room, BBQ and picnic.

Tariff: \$40 per person, per night. Minimum occupancy charge of 40 persons for 2 nights applies. Additional charge for long weekends and functions.

HOOPER BUNKHOUSE

Modest in its fittings, the bunk-style accommodation provides a place to sleep while you relax in our beautiful natural environment and take advantage of our adventurous activities or spend time making use of the numerous facilities.

The Hooper Bunkhouse is close to our Environment Centre and our arts, crafts and vocational learning centre so it is perfect for groups who want some facilitated activities.

Bunk-style accommodation for up to 50 guests in 6 rooms (BYO bedding unless pre-arranged), free WiFi, a modern well-equipped self-catering kitchen, large communal dining room and BBQ.

Tariff: \$40 per person, per night. Minimum occupancy charge of 25 persons for 2 nights applies. Additional charge for long weekends and functions.

RYMILL CENTRE

The Rymill Centre offers quality meeting room facilities and presents a tranquil and very private setting for conferences, classroom-based learning and training.

A spacious, light and bright room opens out on to a balcony that overlooks the beautiful setting and glimpses of our resident wildlife on one side and to the other, an enclosed courtyard that leads directly to the accommodation.

Bunk-style accommodation for up to 82 guests in 15 rooms (BYO bedding, unless pre-arranged), free WiFi, commercial grade kitchen, dining and conference space, as well as Lower Rymill 'break out' rooms.

Tariff: \$40 per person, per night. Minimum occupancy charge of 60 persons for 2 nights applies. Additional charge for long weekends and functions.



ACCOMMODATION AT WOODHOUSE

We specialise in group accommodation for school camps, corporate conferences, weddings, birthdays, family reunions, sporting groups and more. Day entry activities included, BYO bedding unless pre-arranged,



CHALETS

The three Chalets provide peaceful tranquil settings for a close-knit adventure, sleeping up to six people. Small in size but bursting with opportunities, you can relax in the family room (a combined kitchen and dining), and connect over a board game or sit out on the grass and indulge in some nature craft.

Tariff: \$35 per person, per night. Minimum occupancy charge of 3 persons for 2 nights applies. Additional charge for long weekends and functions.

CAMPING

Our site has numerous outdoor unpowered camping areas, for the experienced camper, or those looking for an adventure. These camping areas include adjacent shower and toilet blocks, undercover BBQ facilities and campfire areas, all set on 54 hectares of tree-studded countryside. Tariff per night: child \$18, adult \$22, family (2 adults, 2 children) \$70

SEEONEE HILLS

Situated on Mullers Road, Carey Gully and accommodates 40 guests in 3 rooms. It includes an adjoining recreation room and a large self-catered kitchen. Set on several acres adjacent to the Mt George Conservation Park and only 3km from Woodhouse, guests have the opportunity to enjoy the seclusion of Seeonee. Guests can also enjoy all the activities on offer at Woodhouse, which is a 5 minute drive or 40-minute walk away. Only rainwater is in use at Seeonee. Closed to public between December-April inclusive. Tariff: \$500 flat fee per night, minimum 2 nights. Additional charge for long weekends and functions.

LONES HUT HIRE

Basic carpeted meeting shed with chairs, fridge, kitchen sink and fire pit. Tariff: \$100 per day hire (9am-5pm) in addition to Day Entry fee per person.

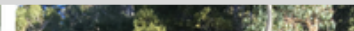
